## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING ELLIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 6

- I. Call to Order, Roll Call, Certification of a Quorum, and Invocation: Commissioner McCormack called the meeting to order and declared a quorum present and confirmed that proper notifications were posted on the District's website and at the meeting place. Chief Curry led the invocation.
- II. Approve the minutes of both the Monday, August 9, 2021 regular meeting and the Monday, August 23, 2021 Public Hearing and Meeting to Adopt the Tax Rate: Commissioner Malone moved to approve the minutes of these two meetings as written, Commissioner Johnston seconded, motion carried unanimously.

## III. Financial Matters

- A. Review the financial report from the Treasurer for August 2021: Commissioner Bill Howell, Treasurer, gave the August 2021 Treasurer's Report. He stated the balance of the capital account as of 8/31/21 was \$659,215.63 and the checking balance was \$100,705.96. The August bills were \$77,294.90 (\$44,957.09 for EC ESD#6 and \$32,337.81 for ESD6 VFD.) The Forreston VFD August 2021 receipts were \$8,510.64. Commissioner McCormack asked for any questions or corrections to the report, there being none, he requested that the Treasurer's Report be filed for audit.
- **B.** Receive and approve payment of the ECESD#6 bills: Commissioner Malone moved to approve the payment of the August 2021 bills as presented. Commissioner Beer seconded, motion carried unanimously.
- **IV. Public Comments:** There were no comments from the public.

## VI. Operational Matters

- A. Receive Chief Wes Curry's Forreston VFD monthly report regarding emergency operations, response times, call volume, training, management activities and membership: (Some items may require action) Chief Curry reported for the month of August, they had 20 runs, of which 4 were EMS assist, 9 motor vehicle accidents, and 3 structure fires
  - Emergency Generator consider purchasing generators for 2 stations: Chief Curry reported the information hasn't changed since his report last month. No action was taken.
  - Service Provider Contract with ECESD#6 status report on reviewing and executing the revised contract: Chief Curry informed the commissioners that another review session will be conducted very soon with Commissioner McCormack, Chief Escamilla and the Forreston VFD Board of Directors.
- B. Receive report from Chief Jake Escamilla on ESD#6 VFD and ECESD#6 regarding emergency operations, response times, call volume, training, management activities and membership including the following: (Some items may require action) Chief Escamilla reported for the month of August, they had 120 calls, of which they responded to 54 and 78 were EMS.
  - **ISO review of the district** Chief Escamilla reported that the review is still on temporary hold awaiting ISO's visit to the District.
  - P-25 Public Safety Radio conversion status: Escamilla reported that Motorola's installation crew is currently installing the new radios in the District's apparatus and then they will be in service and activated on the network soon.
  - Update on ESD6 VFD Station 1 proposal from CAS Septic Service, LLC. to
    expand the existing system to accommodate increased usage of the station:
    Chief Escamilla reported that the entirely new on-sight sewage facility with a lowpressure dosing system is completed and in service.
- C. Set the date and time for the next ECESD#6 regular meeting.

  Without objection, Commissioner McCormack set the date for the District's next regular meeting to Monday, OCT 11, 2021, at 6:30 PM.
- VII. Comments from Commissioners on future District-related administrative or operational issues: Commissioner Malone reminded the commissioners that the SAFE-D Convention in Ft. Worth is coming up in September. All five commissioners and both chiefs are planning to attend for training and general ESD information.
