In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, and Texas Health and Safety Code Chapter 775, notice is hereby given of a Public Hearing conducted by the Board of Commissioners of the Ellis County Emergency Services District No. 6, to be held at the **ESD #6 VFD BUILDING LOCATED AT 1816 FM 66, ONE MILE WEST OF I-35E**, Waxahachie, Texas, at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, **August 22, 2022**.

The following agenda items will be discussed, considered, and action taken as appropriate:

- I. Call to order, Roll Call, Certification of a Quorum, and Invocation
- II. Public Comments

Any individual may address the Emergency Services District Board of Commissioners on relevant issues affecting the District that are either on the current agenda and/or are not a current agenda item, after completing the proper form, for not more than 3 minutes per agenda item or 3 minutes total on any items not on the current agenda. Any comment from a member of the public requiring deliberation or decision on an issue not on the current agenda will be addressed by; the District's Board only as authorized by Section 551.042 of the Government Code. **The Secretary must receive the completed request 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the Regularly Scheduled Meeting.**
- III. Consider taking action regarding the budget for fiscal year October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023;
- IV. Conduct a public hearing on the proposal to increase property taxes;
- V. Take a record vote on the District's 2022 tax rate, adopt an Order Levying Taxes, authorize filing the Order with the Ellis County Tax Assessor / Collector and;
- VI. Acknowledge and approve posting of statement regarding adopted tax rate to the home page of the District's website.
