Any comment from a member of the public requiring deliberation or decision on an issue not on the current agenda will be addressed by; the District's Board only as authorized by Section 551.042 of the Government Code. **The Secretary must receive the completed request 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the Regularly Scheduled Meeting.**

IV. Discuss and consider acting action regarding the 2023-24 tax rate, including:

- (a) establishing a proposed tax rate
- (b) taking a record vote and scheduling a public hearing
- (c) authorizing expense and publication of "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase"
- (d) acknowledging and approving posting of "Notice About 2023-24 Tax Rate" and "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" to home page of the District's website.
